

# AUDITORS REPORT TO THE MEMBERS

We have audited the annexed balance sheet of Centre for Peace and Development Initiatives - (CPDI) as at June 30, 2012 and the related income and expenditure account, cash flow statement and statement of changes in equity, together with the notes forming part thereof, for the year then ended and we state that we have obtained all the information and explanations which, to the best of our knowledge and belief, were necessary for the purposes of our audit.

It is the responsibility of the Company's management to establish and maintain a system of internal control, and prepare and present the above said statements in conformity with the approved accounting standards and the requirements of the Companies Ordinance, 1984. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these statements based on our audit.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the auditing standards as applicable in Pakistan. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the above said statements are free of any material misstatement. An audit includes examining on test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the above said statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting policies and significant estimates made by the management, as well as, evaluating the overall presentation of the above said statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion and, after due verification, we report that:

- (a) in our opinion, proper books of accounts have been kept by the Company as required by the Companies Ordinance, 1984;
- (b) in our opinion:
  - (i) the balance sheet and income and expenditure account together with the notes thereon have been drawn up in conformity with the Companies Ordinance, 1984 and are in agreement with the books of account and are further in accordance with accounting policies consistently applied;
  - (ii) the expenditure incurred during the year was for the purpose of the Company's business; and
  - (iii) the business conducted, investments made and the expenditure incurred during the year were in accordance with the objects of the company;
- (c) in our opinion and to the best of our information and according to explanations given to us, the balance sheet, income and expenditure account, cash flow statement and statement of changes in equity together with the notes forming part thereof conform with approved accounting standards as applicable in Pakistan, and, give the information required by the Companies Ordinance, 1984, in the manner so required and respectively give a true and fair view of the state of the Company's affairs as at June 30, 2012 and of the surplus, its cash flows and changes in equity for the year then ended; and
- (d) in our opinion no Zakat was deductible at source under the Zakat and Ushr Ordinance, 1980 (XVIII of 1980).

# CPDI- CENTRE FOR PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

#### 1. INCORPORATION AND ACTIVITIES

The company was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee on July 17, 2008 under the Companies Ordinance, 1984 with the object to promote peace, develop intiatives for well being of anong the people of Pakistan.

#### 2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### 2.1 Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with approved accounting standards, as applicable in Pakistan. Approved accounting standards comprise of Accounting and Financial Reporting Standard for "Medium-Sized Entities" (MSEs) issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan and provisions or directives of the Companies Ordinance, 1984. In case requirements differ, the provisions or directives of the Companies Ordinance, 1984 shall prevail.

### 2.2 Accounting Conventions

These financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

### 2.3 Operating fixed assets

#### Owned assets

Operating fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and any impairment (if any). Depreciation is charged at the rate specified in the note on reducing balance method. No depreciation is charged on assets disposed off during the year, whereas, full year's depreciation is charged on additions during the year. Normal maintenance and repairs are charged to income as and when incurred. Major renewals and improvements are capitalized. Gain and losses on disposal of assets are taken to profit and loss account.

#### 2.4 Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprise of cash in hand and at banks. Cash equivalents are short term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash.

#### 2.5 Trade & other payables

Liabilities for trade & other amounts payable are carried at cost which is the fair value of the consideration to be paid in future for goods and services received, whether or not billed to the company.

#### 2.6 Revenue recognition

Income from Specific Grants, Research Grants and Contracts is included to the extent of the expenditure incurred during the year, together with any related contributions towards overhead costs. Income from specific endowments not expended in accordance with the restrictions of the endowment is transferred from the income and expenditure account to specific endowments. Income from other services rendered is included to the extent of completion of the contract or services concerned and is measured at the fair value of the consideration receivable. All income from short-term deposits and general endowment asset investments is credited to the Income and Expenditure Account on a receivable basis.
